#### SAC Principal's Report

#### September / October 2024

**Opening –** we had a great opening this year – the kids seemed to have settled in very well and are very responsive to the procedures and when we need to change things up!

**Curriculum Night –** The evening was well attended – we didn't have a gathering in the gym at the beginning and parents went right to their first session! A lot of positive feedback was provided as the parents were leaving the building!

**School Photos –** photos have been held along with the retake day – everything went well. Grade 9 photos are scheduled for Nov 26 with retakes sometime in January.

**Terry Fox Walk** – We were able to schedule the walk around our ILT blocks and allowed students in each grade to have their own day/time for the walk on the trail! Students were excellent representatives of the school when on the trail.

**Orange Shirt Day –** was celebrated here on Friday, Sept 27th. Students wore orange to show our support and learn about the impact of the Residential School System in Canada.

**The Cafeteria** is up and running with new menu items! The food looks great with more options available to students every day.

**Randy's Pizza** – Students started going to Randy's the middle of September. Grade 8 students are able to go with parent permission on Tuesday and Thursdays while grade 9 students are able to go on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays with parent permission.
